Background

The Group was started in 1987 and became affiliated to Plant Heritage in the UK, sharing its aim to conserve and re-establish garden-worthy plants that have become rare or lost for a variety of reasons, and thus help preserve our unique plant heritage. Plant Heritage Guernsey is a Registered Guernsey Charity.

With active involvement and contributions from members, we continue to set up and maintain plant collections of local interest. We have a large collection of nerines, many with specific Guernsey connections, which achieved National Collection status in 2017. We also have a collection of 19thC clematis, donated by Raymond Evison, Caparne Iris and the collection of camellias at Government House.
